That I, WILLIAM R. TIMMONS, JR., in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY AND NO/100 - - - - DOLLARS,

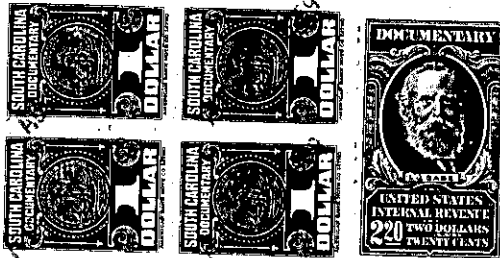
to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said GRACE A. SIMMONS, Her Heirs and Assigns:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot Number 87 of a subdivision known as McSwain Gardens, a plat of which is of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG at Page 75, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Northern side of McSwain Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 86 and 87 and running thence N 27-50 W approximately 196 feet to a point in a branch, the joint rear corner of Lots 86 and 87; thence with said branch as a line approximately N 73-50 E approximately 91.9 feet to a point in said branch, the joint rear corner of Lots 87 and 88; thence S 27-50 E approximately 177.8 feet to a concrete monument on the Northern side of McSwain Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 87 and 88; thence with the Northern side of McSwain Drive S 62-10 W 90 feet to the point of beginning.

THIS deed is executed subject to existing and recorded restrictions and rights-of-way.

GRANTEE to pay 1959 taxes.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named and Her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
