Know All Men by These Presents:

That O.P. Anders, Sr. in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of ~~XXXXXX~~ DOLLARS,  
and exchange of property valued at \$3500.00,

to the grantor(s) in hand-paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s) O.F. Anders and his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or bit of land in Austin-Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on the south side of Peters Creek, bounded on the east by lands of John B. Tate, on the south by C.F. Verdin (formerly lands of the L.A. Fowler Estate) and on the west by R.C. Kendricks, and more fully described as follows: BEGINNING at a stone (iron pin) in the center of settlement road entering the farm, corner of M.G. Verdin and estate of Mrs. Gertrude F. Verdin, and running thence S. 84 W. 7.75 to a stone; thence S. 83-15 W. to a stone, corner of R.C. Kendrick; thence along Kendrick's line, N. 19 W. 20.00 to a point in center of Peters Creek, poplar on south bank; thence down the meanders of said Creek, N. 81-30 as the line 3.35 to bend; thence still down the center of said creek as the line, N. 66 E. 7.78 to a point in the center of the creek, M.G. Verdin corner; thence along Verdin line, S. 11-45 E. 22.09 to the beginning corner, containing 20.20 acres, more or less, according to a copy of plat of survey made for the Federal Land Bank of Columbia by R.E. Dalton, Surveyor, June 20, 1919.

This conveyance carries with it an easement of right-of-way for the purpose of ingress and egress through, over and across property situate in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid, from the above described tract, beginning at southeast corner (stone), extending therefrom through lands of Cromer, O.P. Anders and C.F. Verdin to settlement road leading from the Greenville-Woodruff Highway to farm of M.G. Verdin, said easement being the same as was granted to J.T. & Ola C. Cromer by M.G. and C.F. Verdin recorded in Book 240, page 325, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County,

This is the same property conveyed to grantor herein by J.T. and Ola C. Cromer by deed recorded in Book 413, page 417, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

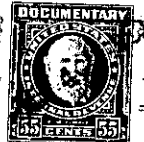
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.
