Highway No. 276 (Travelers Rest-Caeser's Head Road), being known and designated as Lot No. 17 on a plat of the property of the "Nannie K. Hunt Estate", plat made by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated Nov. 15 & 16, 1951, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book AA, page 134, and having, according to said plat, which is hereby incorporated by reference, the following courses and distances, to-wit:
