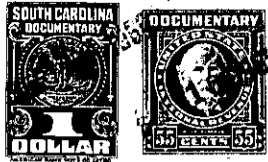

Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, John Charles Barnett in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and No/100 (\$500.00) - - - - - DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Vera C. Duff, her heirs and assigns forever; all my undivided one-half interest in:

ALL THAT CERTAIN PIECE, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being designated as Lot No. 13 of Hunt's Villa according to plat made by C. C. Jones and Associates, Engineers, January 23, 1956, said lot fronting on the Eastern side of White Horse Road and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on White Horse Road at the joint front corners of Lots No. 12 and 13 and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 80-04 E. 135.7 feet to an iron pin in the Western line of Lot No. 14; thence along the line of that lot, N. 10-34 E. 82.2 feet to an iron pin at the converging rear corners of Lots No. 13, 14 and 15; thence along the line of J. M. Hunt and Louise J. Hunt Property, N. 78-50 W. 135 feet to the Eastern side of White Horse Road; thence along White Horse Road, S. 11-10 W. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence still along White Horse Road, S. 10-11 W. 15 feet to the beginning corner.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
