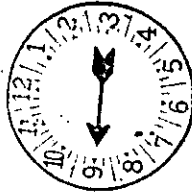

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT

We, B. F. Reeves and Myrtis O. Reeves,

in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand and No/100 (\$2000.00) Dollars and assumption of mortgage in favor of Laurens Federal Savings and Loan Association ~~Dollars~~,

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by T. C. Abbott and Ivy B. Abbott,

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto said T. C. Abbott and Ivy B. Abbott

for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them, his or her heirs and assigns, forever, in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described property, to wit:
