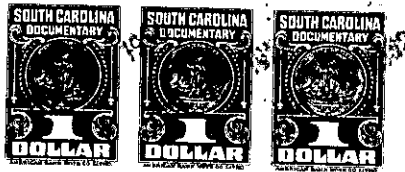

in consideration of the sum of Fourteen Hundred and Fifty (\$1450.00) - - - - - DOLLARS,

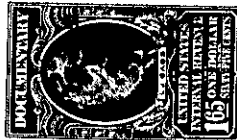
to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s) Eddie Eugene Pollard and his heirs and assigns forever:

ALL MY RIGHT, TITLE AND INTEREST IN AND TO:

All of that certain parcel or lot of land situated on the south side of the Ansel School Road, about two miles northward from the City of Greer, Oneal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being Lot No. 1 of the property of J.C. Bruce, according to survey and plat by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated September 16, 1953, recorded in Plat Book FF, page 183, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a nail and stopper in the center of said Ansel School Road, and running thence along said road, N. 77-45 E. 146 feet to a nail and stopper; thence S. 12-53 W. 263 feet along the west line to an iron pin; thence N. 77-45 W. 180.5 feet to a stake on the east side of a dirt road; thence along said road, N. 20-20 E. 245.5 feet to the beginning corner.
