a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina
and having its principal place of business at
Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration
of the sum of One and no/100 Dollars,
and the premises

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee
hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto
Gwen N. Bagwell, her heirs and assigns forever:

All of that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
known as lot no. 124 on plat of East Lynne Addition made by Dalton &
Neves, May, 1933 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County
S. C., in plat book H at page 220 and having the following metes and
bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Johnson Street, at
the joint front corner of lots nos. 123 and 124; thence with the line
of lot no. 123, N 61-10 W, 200 feet to an iron pin in the line of pro-
perty now or formerly of Boland; thence with the line of Boland, N 28-
50 E, 50 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of lots 124 and
125; thence with line of lots 125, 126 and 127, S 61-10 E, 200 feet to
an iron pin on the northwestern side of Johnson Street; thence with the
northwestern side of Johnson Street S 28-50 W, 50 feet to the point of
beginning.

This deed is executed in order to correct an error in the attestation
clause of deed recorded in deed book 612 at page 243 wherein the
identical property above described was conveyed to the above grantee by
the above grantor.

belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
