Know All Men by These Presents:

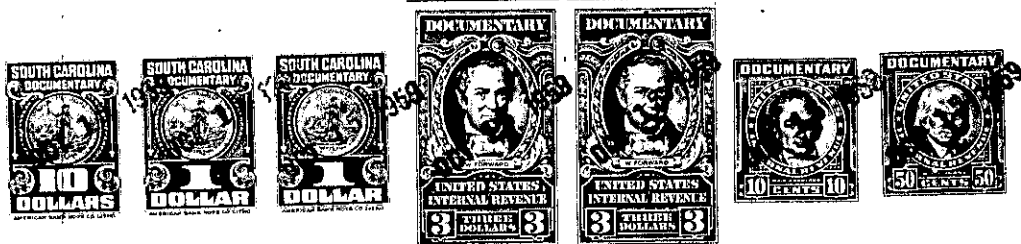

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. C. COLLINS, SR., His Heirs And Assigns,

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the Town of Mauldin, on the Miller Road, and having according to plat of property made by J. C. Hill, Surveyor, said plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book TT at Page 49, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a nail in the center of the Miller Road at the joint corner of the property of J. E. Whiteside and running thence N. 13 E. 577.5 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of the Gilliland property, N. 73-30 W. 1,518 feet to a stone; thence S. 11-15 W. 577.5 feet to an iron pin; thence along line of property of J. E. Whiteside, S. 73-30 E. 1,499.4 feet to a nail in the center of Miller Road, the point of the beginning, and containing twenty acres, be the same more or less.

This is a portion of the same property conveyed to my father, J. E. Whiteside, by deed of Sarah C. McSwain, et al., April 5, 1940, and of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 220, at Page 259.
