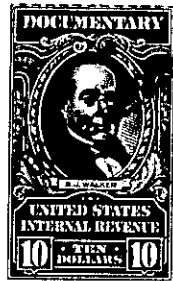

to US in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. W. NORWOOD, JR., AS TRUSTEE FOR ELI LILLY AND COMPANY UNDER TRUST INDENTURE DATED OCTOBER 5<sup>th</sup>, 1959 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. W. NORWOOD, JR., as Trustee for Eli Lilly and Company under Trust Indenture dated October 5<sup>th</sup>, 1959 his successors and assigns forever:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate on the Northeast side of Lake Fairfield Drive near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina being shown as Lot No. 72, Section I, on plat of Lake Forest made by Piedmont Engineering Service dated July, 1953 recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book GG page 17 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Lake Fairfield Drive at joint front corners of Lots 71 and 72 and runs thence with the line of Lot 71 N. 31-40 E, 207.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 61-45 E., 92.3 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 73 S. 27-04 W., 220 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Lake Fairfield Drive; thence along Lake Fairfield Drive N. 56-06 W., 110 feet to the beginning corner.
