That Albert Maddox and Early Mae Maddox in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Eleven Thousand and no/100-----\$11,000.00) DOLLARS, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said More, Inc. an undivided 8/12 interest; unto the said R. M. Caine an undivided 2/12 interest and unto James R. Mann a undivided 2/12 interest, their successors, heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon lying and being at the easterly corner of the intersection of Thompson Street and Church Street, in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being known as Lot No. 3 on the plat of Red Top, which plat is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book C, page 136 and having according to a survey made by Dalton & Neves, dated November, 1959, and recorded in said RMC Office in Plat Book TT, Page 87, the following metes and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the easterly side of Thompson Street joint front corner of lots 3 and 4 of the Red Top property and running thence along the joint line of said lots N 76-10 E 131.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N 10-43 W 40.1 feet to an iron pin joint rear corner of lots 2 and 3, Red Top; thence S 76-38 W 89.8 feet to an iron pin on the southeasterly edge of the right of way of Church Street, thence continuing into Church Street S 76-38 W 40 feet to an point; thence S 7-42 E 23.7 feet to an iron pin at the easterly corner of the intersection of Thompson Street and Church Street; thence S 7-42 E 17.8 feet to the point of beginning.

Subject, however, to the right of way and easement granted to The South Carolina State Highway Department across the northwesterly corner of said lot for the widening of Church Street, which easement is shown on the above mentioned Dalton & Neves plat.

This is the same property conveyed to the grantors by the deed recorded in Deed Book 274, page 283.



TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

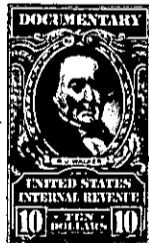

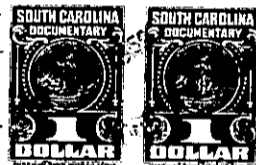
