

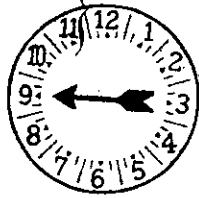

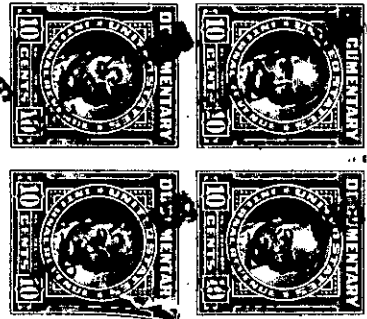
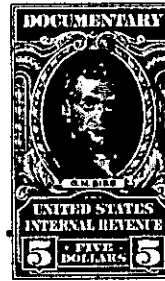

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, HAZEL C. EDWARDS

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of FOURTEEN THOUSAND (\$14,000.00)

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by RAY SLATTON and wife VELDON C. SLATTON

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by  
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said RAY SLATTON and wife  
VELDON C. SLATTON

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 3 on  
plat of property of W.H. Campbell, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for  
Greenville County in Plat Book NN, Page 63, and having, according to  
said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of a dirt road at  
the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 2 and 3, and running thence along  
the line of Lot No. 2 South 76 deg. 35 min. West 167 feet to an iron

the Campbell line South 18 deg. 42 min. East 220 feet to an iron pin
