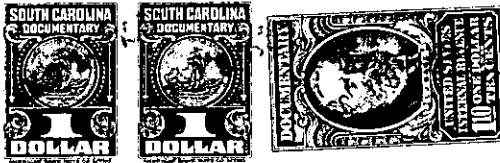
G. Y. STYLES, His Heirs and Assigns:
