Lanford and Sarah Ann McNeill, as Trustees, under Declaration of Trust, dated July 22, 1955, between Dr. M.L. Lanford, et al., as Donors, and Marion E. Lanford, et al., as Trustees,
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on waters of Wild Cat Creek and being known and designated as Lot No. 1 of the property of T.W. Moon as shown on subdivision and plat of same, made by W.P. Morrow on the 11th and 12th of August, 1927, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the road leading to Oneal, where said Oneal Road is intersected with another road, this being the corner of Lots Nos. 2 and 3 on said plat, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 3 and following the road as the line 12.50 chains to a point in the line of the Moon land; thence S. 70 E. 8.00 chains to a stake; thence S. 3 E. 3.10 chains to a stake; thence S. 79 E. 9.10 chains to a stake beyond the Oneal Road; thence N. 20 W. 1.82 to a stake; thence S. 70 E. 17.15 to a stake on Wild Cat Creek; thence along the meanderings of Wild Cat Creek as the line 51.13 chains to a stake at corner of Lot No. 2; thence along the line of this tract, S. 39 W. 12.00 chains to a point; thence continuing along the line of Lot No. 2, S. 71.50 W. 3.95 to the point of beginning in the road to Oneal, and containing 52.30 acres, more or less, and being a part of the land owned by T.
