TITLE TO GRAVE SPACE

Know all men by these presents, that SARA LUCE SAUNDERS for and in consideration of the sum of Forty (\$40.00) Dollars, to her in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents, by MILDRED C. HALL, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said MILDRED C. HALL one sixth (1/6) of/or one (1) grave space of the six grave Lot No. 50, Section L, of SPRINGWOOD CEMETERY, having the following dimensions, to-wit:

North-8' East-3' 9" South-8' West-3' 9"

and more particularly described as follows:

The single grave space situated in the SOUTHWEST CORNER, being parallel to and SOUTH of a single grave bearing the remains of BONNIE DIXON LUCE, same being one grave space on the SOUTHWEST CORNER OF LOT No. 50, SECTION L, of SPRINGWOOD CEMETERY, for the right of burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used exclusively for the right and purposes aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the Charter of the City of Greenville, and all revisions thereof and amendments that may be made thereto, and also subject to the ordinances of said City and the rules, regulations and by-laws of the City Council and Cemetery Trustees or Committee, now in force, or which may hereafter be passed, relating to said Cemetery and the burial of the dead therein.

Together with all and singular, the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances of said premises belonging, or in anywise incident appertaining.

To have and to hold, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said MILDRED C. HALL, her heirs and assigns forever; subject however, to the limitations and conditions hereinbefore imposed.

And she does hereby bind herself, her heirs and assigns to warrant, and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said MILDRED C. HALL, her heirs and assigns, against herself and her heirs, and against every other person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
