Know All Men by these Presents:

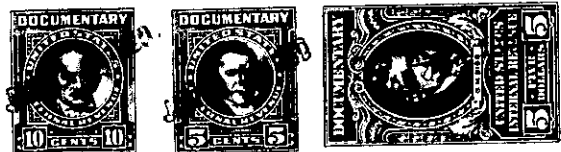
That Frank P. Smith in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Sixty-one Hundred and No/100 -----(\$6100.00) DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said B. F. REEVES, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying in Austin Township, in or near the Town of Simpsonville, on the western side of Oakland Avenue, shown as Lot 10 and the southern one-half of Lot 9 on a plat of the property of I. C. Triplett recorded in Plat Book A, Page 391, also shown as Lot 2 in a subdivision of the lands of Fred L. Howard, prepared by E. E. Gary, dated January 9, 1948, and according to said plat being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Oakland Avenue at the joint line of Lots 10 and 11 and running thence S. 82 1/2 W. 182 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 7 1/2 W. 75 feet to an iron pin in the center of the rear line of Lot 9; thence through the center of said lot N. 82 1/2 E. 177 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Oakland Avenue; thence with the western side of said avenue S. 11-0 E. 75 feet to the beginning.

This being the same property conveyed to the grantor by deed recorded in Deed Book 342, Page 295, as corrected by deed of H. W. Abbott to be recorded herewith.

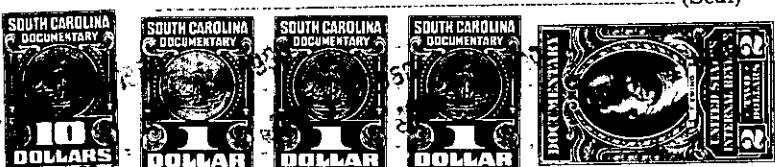
