Long, her Heirs and Assigns, forever:

- (1) All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Ward I of the City of Greenville on the South side of Croft Street, and being known and designated as Lot No. 1, according to Plat made by C. M. Furman, Jr., May, 1923, and being a portion of Lot No. 50, Block C of Stone Land Company.
