H. MAULDIN, his heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land situate on the South side of Azalea Court near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 26 on plat of Pleasantburg Forest, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August, 1956, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book GG, page 163, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Azalea Court at joint front corner of Lots 26 and 27, and running thence with the line of Lot 27, S. 12-19 E., 202.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 72-40 E., 65 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 2-05 E., 180 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Azalea Court; thence with the curve of Azalea Court (the chord being N. 89-32 W), 104 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Azalea Court; thence continuing with Azalea Court, S. 76-47 W., 8.1 feet to the point of beginning.
