CHARTER

BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

OLLIE WORTH

FRANCES B. HOLTZCLAW and F. DEAN RAINEY

both of

Greenville, S. C.

did on the 22nd day of March, 19 60, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is MORRISON FOOD SERVICES OF SOUTH CAROLINA, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

(a). To introduce, erect, provide, maintain, operate, lease, purchase, acquire, hold, enjoy and dispose of by sale, lease or otherwise, in any town, city or borough of the United States of America, coffee houses, restaurants, eating houses, inns, drive-ins, taverns or places of entertainment or refreshment, with power to contract with states, towns, cities or boroughs or any municipal corporation or other corporation or body politic, or any person or persons, and to make and execute any and all agreements for the rental or operation of such coffee houses, restaurants, eating houses, inns, drive-ins, taverns or places of entertainment and refreshment in the United States of America.

(b). To acquire by purchase, subscription or otherwise, and to own, hold, sell, negotiate, assign, dispose of, exchange, transfer, pledge or mortgage, guarantee, deal in, loan or borrow money upon all kinds and forms of securities, shares of capital stock, script, bonds, coupons, debentures, trust certificates, certificates of interest, warrants of all kinds, and interim receipts and certificates issued or created by, or claims against any corporation, joint stock company, trust or association, public or
