

(m). To have one or more offices to carry on all or any part of its operations and business, without restrictions or limit as to amount, in any or all of the states, districts, territories or colonies of the United States of America, and in all foreign countries; to enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind, for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association, corporation or estate.

(n). To purchase or otherwise acquire, own, hold, mortgage, pledge, sell or otherwise dispose of and deal in real estate and personal property of every class and description, subject, however, to the laws of each state, district, territory or country where the same may be located.

(o). To act in all capacities as representatives and/or agent, both general and special, and as collector, collector and/or broker for insurance companies, corporations, associations of any and all kinds; and as such representatives and agents to represent local offices, employ collectors, collect, sell and adjust losses for business of all kinds, in the operation, pursuit and furtherance of such aforesaid representation and agency.

(p). To erect, build, construct, purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, own, provide, establish, maintain, lease, lease and operate factories and warehouses, refrigerating and cold storage plants, depots, buildings, structures, offices, houses, roads, machinery, plants, vehicles or vessels, and all other things of whatsoever kind and nature, within and without the State of Texas, and in any part of the world, and in any part of the world, wherever, and in all vicinities in connection with any or all of the objects hereinbefore or hereinafter set forth.

(q). To apply for, obtain, register, lease, purchase or otherwise acquire, and to hold, use, own, operate and improve and to sell, assign, or otherwise dispose of any trademark, trade name, patents, franchises, licenses, agreements and procedures used in connection with or secured under business process of the United States of America, or elsewhere or elsewhere, or elsewhere, and to acquire any such trademark, trade name, patents, licenses, franchises and the like, or any such property as aforesaid, and further, to purchase, acquire, apply for, use, lease, register, hold, own or sell or otherwise dispose of, any and all copyrights, trademarks, franchises and distinctive marks.

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
