WHEREAS,

W. GENE FULLER of Rt. 1, Taylors, S. C. GREENVILLE CO. S. C.
and
W. HOMER FULLER, of Rt. 3, Piedmont, S. C. MAR 24 4 45 PM 1960

did on the 22nd day of March, 19 60, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.
- SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is GREENVILLE INVESTMENT FUND, INC.
- THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to operate an advertising business and handle and manage a collective type investment fund; to make investments in behalf of all stock holders; to buy and sell stocks, bonds, securities, real estate, personal property, both as principal and agent; to do all things incident or necessary to such businesses and in general carry on any business not contrary to the laws of the State of South Carolina, and to have and exercise all of the powers, rights and privileges conferred by the laws of the State of South Carolina upon corporations organized thereunder.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars payable at the call of the board of directors

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is One Thousand (1,000) of the par value of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 24th day of February, 19 60, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: W. Gene Fuller and W. Homer Fuller

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, W. Gene Fuller ; as Vice-President, W. Homer Fuller ; as Secretary, W. Homer Fuller ; as Treasurer, W. Gene Fuller

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville Piedmont a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
