HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Leona Fisher, all the right, title and interest of the De-
fendants, Donald Richard Waldrop and James David Waldrop, in the following
described real estate:

"All that lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State
of South Carolina, on the northern side of Moody Road, containing 1.42
acres, more or less, and described as follows:
BEGINNING at a stake in Moody Road and running thence due North
200 feet to an iron pin; thence west 327 feet; thence S. 174 feet to a
point in Moody Road; thence with said Moody Road in an easterly direction
337 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same property more fully des-
