"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about seven miles east of the City of Greenville, containing Two and 5/10 (2.5) acres according to a plat thereof made by J. Mac Richardson, R. L. S., March 1956, and being a portion of the property conveyed to Broadus Durant by the Southeastern Life Insurance Co. on September 29, 1938, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 206 at page 157, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a nail in a county road, the joint western intersection of the said property conveyed to Durant by Southeastern Life Ins.
