

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-nine and 47/100ths (\$7,989.47) Dollars, and assumption of the mortgage WMXXX indebtedness recited below----

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.P. STEVENS & CO., INC.:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Eastern side of Chick Springs Road in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 119 as shown on a plat of Vista Hills, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book P at page 149, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Chick Springs Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 118 and 119, said iron pin being 147.5 feet in a Northerly direction from the Northeastern corner of the intersection of Wellington Avenue and Chick Springs Road, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 118 S. 74-28 E. 172.3 feet to a point in the center of a 15 foot alley; thence with the center line of said alley N. 18-32 E. 83.7 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 119 and 120; thence with the line of Lot No. 120 N. 75-42 W. 176 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Chick Springs Road; thence with the Eastern side of Chick Springs Road S. 15-40 W. 80 feet to the point of beginning.

The above description includes one-half of a 15 foot alley at the rear of this lot, but it is distinctly understood and agreed that the rear seven and one-half feet of this lot, together with the rear seven and one-half feet of the lots adjoining it in the rear, shall be used as a public alley, as shown on said plat for Vista Hills.

This is the identical property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of Arthur W. Kurz, Jr., dated October 30, 1954, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 513 at page 96.

The grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay the balance due on that certain mortgage given by the grantor herein to General Mortgage Co.,
