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sell, mortgage, hypothecate and in any and every way and manner deal in and with goods, wares and merchandise, choses in action and other property in possession or in action, and to make, do and transact all and every kind of business of whatever nature or kind, and also for me and in my name, and as my act and deed to sign, sell, execute, deliver and acknowledge such deeds, leases and assignments of leases, covenants, indentures, agreements, mortgages, bills, bonds, notes, receipts, evidences of debts, releases and satisfaction of mortgages, judgments and other debts and such other instruments in writing and of whatever kind and nature as may be necessary and proper in the premises.

Giving and granting unto my said attorney full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and about the premises as fully and to all intents and purposes as I might or could ^{do} ~~do~~ if personally present, with full power of substitution or revocation hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney, or her substitute or substitutes shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.
