WHEREAS, OLLIE F. WORTH
HAROLD BAILEY, of 100 Meridian St., Taylors, S. C.
and
BEN BOOTLE, Courtland Apartments, Greenville, S. C.

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of
GREENVILLE ROUGHRIDERS MOTORCYCLE CLUB

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 5th day of
May, A. D. 1960, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the **Greenville Piedmont**, a newspaper published in the County of **Greenville**, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is **GREENVILLE ROUGHRIDERS MOTORCYCLE CLUB**

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is
P. O. Box 3187, 1709 Augusta St., GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to promote good and safe practices in the use and operation of motorcycles; to create good public relations with reference to motorcycles in general; to own, lease, mortgage and operate real estate, including race tracks, to conduct and participate in events authorized, encourage and/or sanctioned by the American Motorcycle Association. It is specifically provided, and shall form a part of the Charter, that the Club is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to any member and under no circumstances shall there be a distribution of assets of the Club to members. (This shall not be construed to prohibit the payment of salaries to employees, including members, who actually perform services and expend time on behalf of the corporation.)

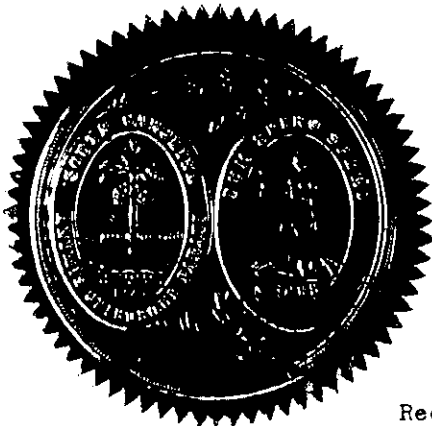

SIXTH: That they desire to be incorporated: **In perpetuity.**

FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested, by Chapter 12, Title 12, Code of 1952, and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be a body politic and corporate, with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities, conferred by said Chapter 12, Title 12, Code of 1952, and Acts amendatory thereto.
