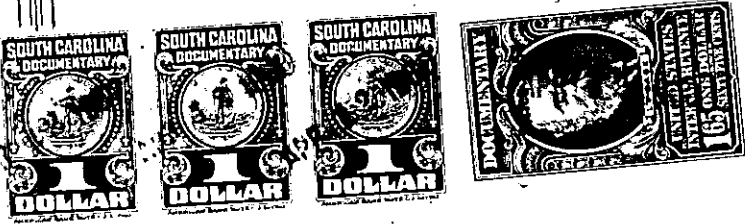

Adams, Agents, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of \$1,240.00 Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Henry Earl Alewine (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Henry Earl Alewine

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Spring Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina beginning at an iron pin on Brushy Creek Road and running thence with said Brushy Creek Road N 14° 35' W 140 feet to an iron pin, thence N 75° 25' E 206.5 feet to an iron pin, thence S 14° 35' E 140 feet to an iron pin, thence S 75° 25' W 206.5 to the beginning corner, being lots Nos. 41 and 43 as shown on Plat of the Piedmont Engineering Service, Greenville, S.C., prepared in August, 1947, and revised in April, 1948, recorded in Plat Book S, page 19, Office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, under authority contained in the power of attorney executed on April 2, 1960, by Mary E.
