CHARTER  
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

JEAN E. HATCH and SUZANN J. HATCH

both of

Greenville, South Carolina

signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is H AND H SPORTS, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is #808 Rutherford Road, GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to engage in promotion  
of sports of all type; to buy, sell, lease, mortgage real property and all  
type of personal property, and to do anything else that is permitted for a  
business corporation to do under the laws of the State of South Carolina.

payable in cash, services or merchandise, in the discretion of the Board of  
Directors.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Fifty (50)  
of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00)----- Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 14th day of  
May, 19 60, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following  
were elected directors: DeWitt C. Hatch, Jean E. Hatch, Ruth E. Harris, Suzann J. Hatch,  
and Dorothy E. Hatch

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, DeWitt C. Hatch ;  
as Vice-President, Ruth E. Harris ; as Secretary, Jean E. Hatch ;  
as Treasurer, Jean E. Hatch

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments  
thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by  
bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice  
of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Piedmont  
a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the  
aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws  
of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to  
commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the  
Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
