Upon the full performance of the conditions and obligations of said note and mortgage hereinabove mentioned, this assignment shall be void and of no effect, and thereupon, in that event the said Citizens and Southern National Bank will reassign to the undersigned its right, title and interest in and to the said lease so acquired under and by virtue of this assignment.

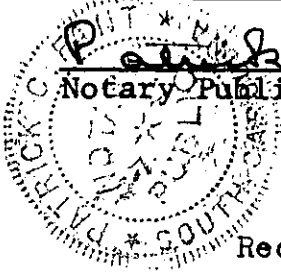
