All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the South side of Willow Spring Drive, in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 10 on plat of Section 7, of East Highlands Estates, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April 1959, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book MM, at page 99, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Willow Spring Drive at joint front corner of Lots 9 and 10 and runs thence with the line of Lot 9, S. 28-22 E., 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 64-24 W., 90 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 11, N. 20-39 W., 150 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Willow Spring Drive; thence with the curve on Willow Spring Drive (the chord being N. 64-11 E., 70 feet) to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by Conyers & Gower, Inc., by deed dated May 14, 1959, recorded in the R.
