to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto COUNTY OF GREENVILLE, a municipal corporation existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL that parcel or strip of land situate, lying and being on the North side of Old Mill Road, near the Town of Mauldin, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being known as Devonshire Road, and being the area measuring twenty-five (25) feet on each side from the center of said Devonshire Road, said center line being as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the North side of Old Mill Road and in the center of Devonshire Road and running thence along the center of said Devonshire Road, N. 19-0 E., 415 feet to a point; thence continuing with the center of Devonshire Road, N. 33-02 E., 103.1 feet to a point; thence continuing with the center of Devonshire Road, N. 19-0 E., 600 feet, said point being the Northern end of the said Devonshire Road.

This strip of land is conveyed to the grantee to be used for road purposes.
