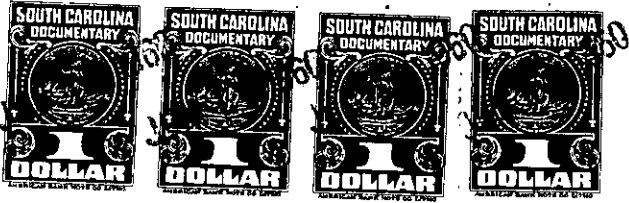
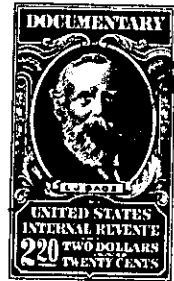

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Gladys C. Knapp, heir heirs and assigns forever, all that lot or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and situate on the third basin of the waters of Lake Lanier; described as follows: Said lot shown on plat made by J. Q. Bruce, Reg. Sur. and dated May 13th. 1959, lot shown on this plat as beginning at the corner of East Lake Shore Drive, and a 20 foot alley used for landing boats, and running along said alley S-84.01-W 117.6 feet to an iron pin at water's edge; thence S-34.41-W 26 feet to an iron pin; thence S-78.00-W 11 feet to end of concrete-wall; thence along this concrete wall 25.2 feet in a Southerly direction; thence N-79.00-E eleven feet to an iron pin; thence N-85.54-E 136 feet to East Lake Shore Drive as shown by iron pin; thence along East Lake Shore Drive N-11.20-W fifty feet to the beginning corner. The above described property is directly across the Drive from lot #647, and this deed carries with it the right to use the 2 piers to the West and one-half of the second set of piers to the South of the above mentioned pair.
