KENNETH BRANNON and ELIZABETH F. BROWN

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Eastern side of Dundee Lane, in Paris Mountain Township, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 65 of a subdivision known as Stratford Forest, and having according to a plat of said subdivision prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated February 25, 1957, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book KK at page 89, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Dundee Lane at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 64 and 65 and running thence with the line of Lot No. 64 N. 75-15 E. 249 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 82; thence with the lines of Lots Nos. 82 and 68 S. 15-45 E. 171.9 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 65 and 66; thence with the line of Lot No. 66 S. 71-00 W. 246.2 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Dundee Lane; thence with the Eastern side of Dundee Lane N. 16-42 W. 190 feet to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to "Protective Covenants Applicable to Stratford Forest", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 578 at page 1, and to drainage and utility easements, if any, affecting said lot.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of Furman University, dated November 13, 1956, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book 567 at page 397.
