All that parcel or lot of land lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being designated as Lot No. 45 as shown on Plat No. Three, Cherokee Forest, prepared by J. Mac Richardson, R.L.S., in January, 1959, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book QQ at pages 36 and 37, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Roberta Drive, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 44 and 45, as shown on said plat, running thence along the line of Lot No. 44 N. 15-58 E. 181.6 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running S. 77-58 E. 100.24 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running along the line of Lot No. 46 S. 15-58 W. 188.7 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Roberta Drive; thence along Roberta Drive N. 74-02 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
