KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Beatrice Whitener, Elizabeth  
S. Cureton and Evelyn S. Long,  
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of  
Fourteen Hundred and No/100 (\$1400.00) Dollars  
to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by South Carolina State Highway Department  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by  
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said South Carolina State  
Highway Department, its Successors and Assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in \_\_\_\_\_ Township,  
County, State of South Carolina

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City  
of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and lying between East  
North Street and East Avenue and being the rear half of a lot conveyed to Aurelia T.  
Munn in Deed Book "I I I", at Page 812 and now lying to the rear of a lot conveyed  
to Central Realty Corporation by the heirs of Clara Snead and having the following  
metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on line of property now or formerly owned by  
Jones, approximately 202 feet from East North Street, and running thence N. 73 1/2  
E. 37 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 28 E. 102 feet to an iron pin in line of property  
owned by Central Realty Corporation; thence S. 72 1/4 W. 43 feet 9 inches to line  
of other lot owned by Central Realty Corporation; thence N. 20-15 W. 102 feet to the  
point of beginning. TOGETHER with all our right, title and interest to the alley-  
way running from said lot to East Avenue. The above lot is shown as Lot No. 33,  
Block 6, Sheet 39, on the City Block Book.

The above is the same property deeded to Beatrice Whitener and Daisy  
Stewart in Deed Book 287, Page 204. Daisy Stewart died November 30, 1949 and  
devised her interest in the above property to the grantors, Elizabeth S. Cureton
