STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, ) SEPARATION AGREEMENT.

This agreement, made this 27th. day of October, 1943, between A. J. Cox, of Route 1, Travelers Rest, South Carolina, hereinafter called the husband, and Elizabeth Cox, of Conestee, South Carolina, hereinafter called the wife, is as follows:

Whereas, unfortunate difficulties and disputes have arisen between these parties and they have separated with the intention of living apart from each other:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, the said wife hereby releases the husband from all obligations of future support, and releases and relinquishes unto the said husband, his heirs, administrators and assigns forever all rights or claims by way of inheritance, dower or descent in and unto the real property of the said husband now owned or hereafter acquired, and all other rights of whatever kind and nature growing out of said marriage relation, including any rights as claimant or distributes in any personal property. The said wife also agrees that she will not incur or contract any debts on his credit and for such he is not to be liable in any way.

It is also agreed that the said wife is freed from all duties and liabilities of any kind to the said husband arising out of the marriage relation, and he agrees that he is not at any time to be a claimant as heir or distributee or otherwise in any property, real or personal, of the said wife.

The parties further agree to inform each other of any change of address within a reasonable time after such change.
