

that the Defendant's obligation to pay \$20.00 per week shall commence upon his reemployment by the Colorado Fuel and Iron Corporation, and be payable each payday thereafter through the registry of this Court.

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER that Defendant pay or cause to be paid to Plaintiff the sum of \$15.00 per month out of the proceeds of sale of said house and lot known as Lot No. 13, Fairlane Circle, Laurel Heights, Greenville, South Carolina, as evidenced by said mortgage, for 18 months commencing with payment due December 1, 1959 and payable on the same day of each month through December 1, 1960; that on approximately December 19, 1961 Defendant pay or cause to be paid out of said proceeds of sale the sum of \$565.00 out of the \$1130.00 lump sum, plus one-half of total interest; that Defendant do forthwith make up the five payments, due July 1 through November 1, of \$15.00 each, totalling \$75.00, or in the alternative, that same be made up, with interest at 7% per annum, out of additional \$565.00 balance to which he will be entitled from the sale of the house when payable on December 19, 1961, as aforesaid; that if any of said sums are paid by said mortgagors prior to the dates on which they are due shown herein, the required sums be paid forthwith to Plaintiff; that Defendant further forthwith furnish an authorization and direction to said Allen B. Vaughn and Kathleen C. Vaughn, Greenville, South Carolina, and/or any agency collecting said indebtedness, to make such payments directly to Plaintiff; that Plaintiff's endorsement on the check of such persons or agency shall be sufficient receipt and acquittance of Defendant as to each such sum so paid.

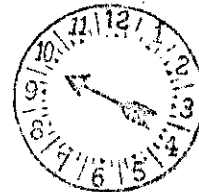
