to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Elizabeth Haynsworth Taylor and Harry J. Haynsworth III, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate and being in the State and County aforesaid, Cleveland Township, on the north side of Echo Drive, beginning at a new corner of Lots No. 56 and 58 on Echo Drive, running thence with Echo Drive S 57- 39 E 40 feet to an angle; thence S 67 -51 E 50 feet to old corner of Lots No. 56 and 54; thence S 72 - 45 E 10 feet to new corner; thence N 28- E 150 feet to new corner on back line; thence N 66-30 W 73 feet to new corner of Lots No. 56 and 58; thence S 38 - 20 W 150 feet to the beginning corner, and being lot No. 56 of Section "A" Development of Caesar's Head property of Paris Mountain-Caesar's Head Co. This property was conveyed to the grantor by deed of C. F. Haynsworth dated June 1, 1952, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book 457, Page 303.

Also all that piece, parcel or lot of land lying to the east of, and adjoining, the above lot, beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Echo Drive and running thence with Echo Drive S 72 - 45 E 29.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N 25 - 10 E 149.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N 70 -00 W 21.6 feet to an iron pin, corner of the above lot; thence with the above lot S 28 -00 W 150 to the point of beginning, being a portion of Lot No. 54 of Section "A" Development of Caesar's Head property of Paris Mountain - Caesar's Head Co. This property was conveyed to the grantor by deed of Dorothy W. Marchant by deed dated Oct. 23, 1957, to be recorded.

Together with the right of the grantor in the alley or driveway along the rear of said lots and leading from Caesar's Head Drive.
