KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, Hal P. Mayfield, Mrs. Eueine M. Southerlin, Mrs. Willie M. Talley, Mrs. Alma M. Bates, William D. Mayfield, Jesse E. Mayfield and John T. Mayfield hereby agree among ourselves upon the following contract and agreement, which agreement is to be binding upon each of us and upon the heirs and assigns of each of us.

The parties above named are seven of the nine heirs of George R. and Eula Mayfield. As such, each is the owner of a one-ninth undivided interest in a certain tract of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, containing three hundred seventy-five (375) acres more or less, the George R. Mayfield homeplace. By deed dated August 22, 1960, Wix C. Mayfield conveyed his one-ninth undivided interest to the parties to this contract and George Rolls Mayfield, Jr. By virtue of that deed each of the above parties plus George R. Mayfield became the owner of a one-eighth undivided interest in this tract of land. By deed dated August 22, 1960, George R. Mayfield, Jr. conveyed his undivided one-eighth interest to Hal P. Mayfield. The parties to this agreement, Wix C. Mayfield and George R. Mayfield, Jr. are all of the children and are all of the heirs at law of George R. Mayfield and Eula Mayfield. Hal P. Mayfield is the owner of an undivided one-fourth interest in this land and the other six parties hereto are each owners of a one-eighth interest thereto.

The subject matter of this contract and agreement is a certain tract of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing three hundred seventy-five (375) acres, more or less, and known as the George R. Mayfield homeplace, located on the South Saluda River. It is the same tract of land as is described in the deed from George R.

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
