to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto CHARLES F. WEBB AND JAMES SMITH, THEIR HEIRS AND ASSIGNS:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina on the headwaters of Mathers Creek (now known as Mathews Creek), waters of South Saluda River, near the North Carolina line, known as the Zilda Moore Place and being the same place where Zilda Moore resided at the time of her death, containing ten (10) acres, more or less, being the same property devised to the grantor herein by Will of John J. McSwain as recorded in the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 351 at file 7, and being the same property conveyed to the said John J.
