ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as portions of Lots Nos. 24 and 25 of a subdivision known as Highland Terrace as Shown on plat thereof recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at page 120 and also being the greater portion of Lot No. 24, and a small portion of Lot No. 25, together with an additional 8 foot triangular strip to the west of Lot No. 24 as shown on plat thereof made by C. C. Jones and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book BB, at page 140, and having, according to a revised plat thereof made by C. C. Jones on September 21, 1954, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of Fairview Avenue at the joint corner of Lots 24 and 25 as shown on the Jones revised plat, which point is 73 feet northwest of the intersection of an unnamed street, and running thence along the northeast side of Fairview Avenue, N. 50-29 W., 20 feet to an iron pin at the original joint corner of Lots 24 and 25; thence continuing along the northeast side of Fairview Avenue N. 64-17 W., 55 feet to an iron pin at a point 30 feet southeast of the joint corner of Lots 23 and 24 on the original Highland Terrace plat; thence N. 27-01 E., 167.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 66-04 E. 80.1 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 25 on the Jones revised plat which point is 64.3 feet from the northeast line of the unnamed street; thence along theline of Lot 25, S. 28-46 W., 175.8 feet to the beginning corner.
