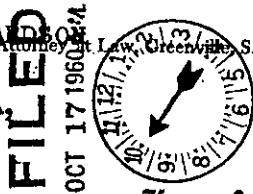

That We, J. T. Hipps, J. P. Hipps, Broadus C. Hipps, R. E. Hipps, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of 1000 and affection and division of estate, DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged); have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Martha Mae Clark

All our several rights, titles and interests in and to a tract of land near Simpsonville, County and State aforesaid, containing 6 acres, more or less, according to survey and plat made by J. Mac Richardson, Reg. Land Surveyor, dated February, 1950, and shown on the plat as tract number 6. It is a portion of the lands left to J. T. Hipps by the will of his father, J. P. Hipps for the term of his natural life and at his death to his bodily heirs. The grantors and the grantee herein represent the life tenant and all of his bodily heirs. The said tract of land begins at a stake at the northwest corner of tract of land this day being conveyed to William G. Hipps and runs thence S. 17-45 E. 835 feet to a stake; thence N. 80-53 W. 341 feet to a stake; thence N 15-10 W. 913 feet to a stake on or near the road; thence S. 69-23 E. 378.6 feet to the beginning corner.

It is understood and agreed that this deed is one of a series in a division of the lands of J. T. Hipps and it is further understood that the said J. T. Hipps is retaining a life estate or a life interest therein.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever. subject to a life estate in J. T. Hipps

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
