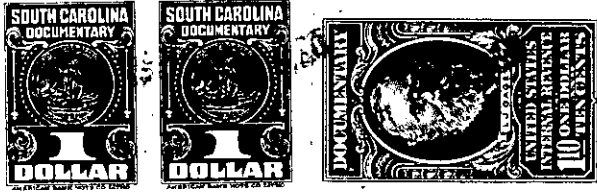

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of United States of America and having ^{one of} its principal place of business at Greenville

in the State of South Carolina, and WALTER W. GOLDWORTHY for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Ninety-five and No/100=-----

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto J. MAYES MAYSON and LOIS F. MAYSON, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being on the North side of Stephenson Lane in Gantt Township, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 23 on Plat of Dixie Farms, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, December, 1939, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "L", at page 5, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Stevenson Lane at joint front corner of Lots 22 and 23 and running thence with the line of Lot 22, N. 26-14 W., 249.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 63-46 W., 160 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 24, S. 26-14 E., 249.8 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Stevenson Lane; thence with Stevenson Lane, N. 63-46 E., 160 feet to the point of beginning.

THIS is a portion of the property conveyed to E. R. Parker by deed of The First Carolinas Joint Stock Land Bank recorded in Deed Book 205, page 180, RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. Thereafter, E. R. Parker conveyed an undivided one-half interest in the above described lot to Walter W. Goldsmith by deed recorded in Deed Book 228, page 69, said RMC Office. Subsequently E. R. Parker died testate leaving his last will which is on file in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, S. C., in Apartment 488, File 25, and by said will he named and constituted The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston as Executor and Trustee, giving it full power to sell and convey the above described property and this conveyance is made pursuant to the power and authority conferred on The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston as Executor and Trustee by the terms of said will.
