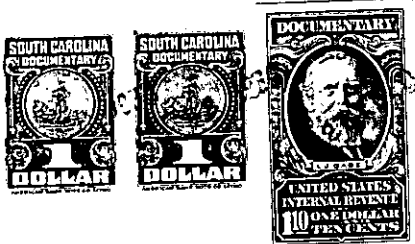
Know All Men by These Presents:

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. D. Wilson, his heirs and assigns:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 4 of the Pine Grove Heights, plat of which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book Y, Page 87, and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the southerly side of Pine Grove Road, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 3 and 4, and running thence with the line of said lots S. 25-30 W., 158 feet; thence S. 64-30 E. 100 feet to joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence with the line of said lots N. 25-30 E. 158 feet to a point on said Pine Grove Road; thence with Pine Grove Road N. 64-30 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
