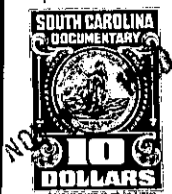

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the city of Greenville, on the east side of Townes Street, and being described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Townes Street, 160 feet north of the northeast corner of the intersection of Townes and Earle Streets, and running thence S. 83-10 E. 105 feet to a stake; thence N. 7-0 E. 50 feet to a pin; thence N. 83-10 W. 105 feet to a pin on the east side of Townes Street; thence with the east side of Townes Street S. 7-0 W. 50 feet to the beginning.

This is the same lot conveyed to Kathryan J. Finley by Sam F. Floyd by deed recorded April 27, 1945 in deed volume 275 page 9.

Kathryan J. Finley departed this life testate as will appear by reference to the records of the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 719 file 7. The grantors are the sole heirs and devisees under the will of Kathryan J. Finley, herein referred to.
