All that piece, parcel or strip of land situate, lying and being in the Judson Mill Village near the City of Greenville in Greenville County, South Carolina and being:

A strip of land thirty (30') feet in width and one hundred thirty eight (138') feet, more or less, in length being a proposed continuation of E Street running South from 5th Street to the Northern boundary of 6th Street.

The within described property is the identical property conveyed to the grantor as the second parcel in a deed from The Cotwool Manufacturing Corporation to Greenville County dated July 11, 1956, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 557 at page 281.
