KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mrs. Rachel Burns

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand and No/100 Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents Wyatt Aiken and Clarence H. Crow, as Trustees for the Executive Committee on Home Missions for Enoree Presbytery

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said WYATT AIKEN and CLARENCE H. CROW, as Trustees for the Executive Committee on Home Missions for Enoree Presbytery, their successors and assigns, forever:

ALL that parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being on-the-North-west-side-of-Edwards-Road-and on the South side of East Lee Road, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, and having, according to a survey made by C. O. Riddle, Surveyor, May 1956, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of East Lee Road, said pin being 294.3 West of an iron pin at the Southwest corner of the intersection of East Lee Road and Edwards Road, and running thence along line of other property of grantor, S. 4-53 E., 220 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 85-50 N., 94.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 4-53 W., 220 feet to an iron pin on the South side of East Lee Road; thence with the South side of East Lee Road, N. 85-50 E., 94.2 feet to the beginning corner, and contains .47 acres.
