MILLER in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Six Hundred and no/100 (\$1600.00) - - - DOLLARS, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said BRUCE MOSELEY, his heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land situate on the West side of West Belvedere Road, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S.C., being shown as Lot No. 176, on plat of South Forest Estates made by Pickell and Pickell, Engineers, August 29, 1955, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book GG, Page 181, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of West Belvedere Road at the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 175 and 176 and running thence along the line of Lot No. 175 S. 85-05 W. 144.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 11-01 E. 80.4 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot No. 177 N. 85-05 E. 135.7 feet to an iron pin on the West side of West Belvedere Road; thence along West Belvedere Road N. 4-55 W. 80 feet to the beginning corner.

This lot is conveyed subject to restrictions applicable to South Forest Estates, which are recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Deed Book 547, page 66.
