Green, the undersigned do hereby agree that the portion of said alley upon which the above described parcels abutt, shall remain forever closed and that the depth of side lines of the respective parcels in question shall be extended by the addition of the said ten feet representing the width of the proposed alley and west corners of said parcels shall hereafter be situate in the property line of the tract of land formerly owned by the said J. T. Childs.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the aforesaid ten foot strip to the undersigned present owners of the respective parcels in question, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
