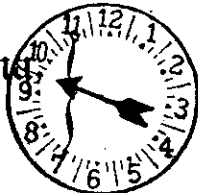

our Lord nineteen hundred and Sixty exhibited her  
County Court  
complaint in the ~~Court of Common Pleas~~, for the County aforesaid, against Linda Faye Willis and  
Joseph Thomas Willis, Defendants

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to  
be heard on the 22nd day of November 1960,  
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged  
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,  
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Fred L. Crow  
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County  
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, upon receipt of \$3500.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release  
unto the said Fred L. Crow

That certain lot of land, with improvements thereon, in the said County  
and State, in the City of Greer, School District 285, Chick Springs  
Township, and lying on the eastern side of James Avenue in the said city,  
and having the following courses and distances:

Beginning at a point on the eastern edge of James Ave. at the corner of  
C. D. Black lot and runs thence with the Black line S. 68-41 E. 80 feet  
to an old iron pin, cornering with property of Fred L. Crow; thence with  
the Crow line the same course for 38.5 feet to an old iron pin, cornering  
with the M.C. Vaughn lot; thence with the Vaughn line S. 20-56 W. 54 feet  
to an old iron pin, cornering with Lewis Cannon property; thence with  
the Cannon line N. 68-59 W. 56 feet to an old iron pin; thence S. 21-37  
W. 27.5 feet to an iron pin on the corner with M. C. Vaughn lot; thence  
with the Vaughn lot N. 68-41 W. 63.4 feet to an old iron pin on the edge  
of said James Avenue; thence with said Avenue N. 21-30 E. 81.8 feet to  
the point of beginning.
