BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

O. K. McCarter and D. C. PRICE,
Of 6411 Briarwood Road, Columbia, S. C., and 303 Trade Street,
Greer, S. C., respectively.

did on the 2nd day of December, 19 60, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration,
signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

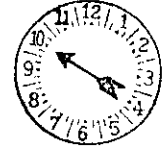
SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is PRICE'S FEED STORE, INCORPORATED

THIRD: That the principal place of business is 303 Trade Street, Greer, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to buy, sell and other-
wise deal in seeds, feeds and related goods.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Forty Thousand (\$40,000.00)----- Dollars
payable fifty percent of stock or 2,000 shares purchased at \$10.00 per share,
in cash and merchandise.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Four Thousand (4,000)
of the par value of Ten (\$10.00)----- Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 3rd day of
September, 19 60, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following
were elected directors: O. K. McCarter, as Chairman, D. C. Price, Velmah A. Price,
and Matrel H. McCarter

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, D. C. Price
as Vice-President, Velmah A. Price ; as Secretary, Matrel H. McCarter
as Treasurer, Matrel H. McCarter

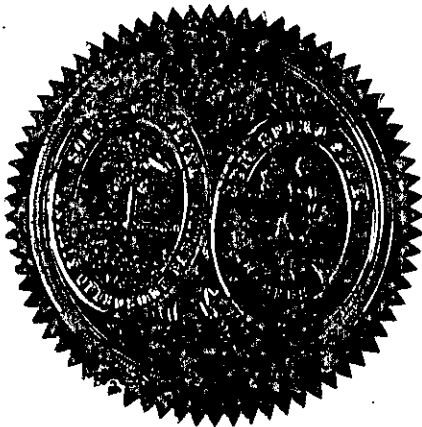
NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments
thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by
bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice
of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Fountain Inn Tribune

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the
aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws
of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to
commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the
Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
